## **POLICY OBJECTIVE:**

1. To ensure that any waste materials that may have long term impact on the Commission and its facilities, such as hydrocarbon contaminated soils are subject to environmental, engineering and regulatory due diligence before they are accepted for use as daily cover.

## **POLICY STATEMENT:**

1. The Didsbury Regional Landfill will accept Hydrocarbon contaminated soil from various suppliers provided the material is within governing regulations that allow the Landfill to use it for daily cover in its municipal waste disposal cell without further treatment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

1. Prior to disposal the waste generator must submit information and laboratory analysis about the disposal material to the CAO or designate.
2. The CAO or designate will review the information as per the operating procedures and let the waste generator know if the waste can be accepted.
3. All waste accepted will be dealt with and tested as per the operations procedures.
4. The waste hauler will be required to pay a disposal fee as per the Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission Fee schedule.
5. The Didsbury Regional Landfill will be responsible for stock piling the soil however any costs associated with the initial dumping of materials from trucks will be the waste generators costs.

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES:**

1. The CAO or designate and the scale attendant shall be responsible for enforcing this Policy.
2. The CAO shall be responsible for updating and reviewing this Policy.
