Policy Title: OIL, OIL FILTERS AND OIL CONTAINERS	Effective Dates: February 24, 2014

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

1. To ensure that any waste materials that may have long term impact on the Commission and its facilities are subject to environmental, engineering and regulatory due diligence before they are accepted for handling and disposal.

POLICY STATEMENT:

1. The Mountain View Regional Transfer Stations will accept oil, oil containers and oil filters subjected to Federal, Provincial and Municipal governing regulations in force by the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act.

BACKGROUND:

1. The Mountain View Regional Transfer Stations will accept non-contaminated oil, oil containers and oil filters at no charge.
2. If the waste hauler spills oil on the Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission property they will be required to pay for all clean-up costs.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES:

1. The waste hauler must inform the scale operator they are hauling oil or oil products.
2. The waste hauler will be required to place the oil products in the oil recycling facility.
3. The CAO or designate will inspect the load for compliance and contamination.
4. The CAO or designate will contact an outside company to pick up the oil products from the Transfer Stations.

5. The CAO shall be responsible for enforcing the Policy.
6. The CAO shall be responsible for updating and reviewing the Policy.
