POLICY OBJECTIVE:

1. To define wastes that are prohibited from disposal at the Landfill and Transfer Stations.

POLICY STATEMENT:

- 1. Prohibited waste includes:
 - a. Any hazardous waste as defined by the Waste Control Regulation;
 - b. Any waste defined as "dangerous" oilfield waste under Guide 58 (Energy and Utilities Board);
 - c. All animal carcasses;

d. Any waste containing asbestos;

Amended February 27, 2017

- e. Biomedical waste that is not rendered inert;
- f. Radioactive waste;
- g. Explosives; and
- h. Bulk liquids
- The CAO or designate reserves the right to determine if a waste is acceptable at the Landfill and Transfer Stations for storage or disposal, which may include soils or materials containing non-hazardous materials, such as those containing high concentrations of chlorides or other such constituents.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES:

- The Site Operator and Scale Operator shall be responsible to inspect loads from prohibited debris
 and to take necessary actions to prevent such waste from entering the Landfill and Transfer Station
 sites.
- 2. The CAO shall be responsible for enforcing this Policy.
- 3. The CAO shall be responsible for updating and reviewing this Policy.
