POLICY OBJECTIVE:

1. To ensure that any waste materials that may have long term impact on the Commission and its facilities, are subject to environmental, engineering and regulatory due diligence before they are accepted for handling, recycling and disposal.

POLICY STATEMENT:

1. The Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission will accept wire subjected to Federal, Provincial and Municipal governing relations in force by the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act.
2. Wire will only be accepted at the Didsbury Landfill Facility.
3. The hauler of wire will be required to place the wire in a designated area.
4. Any costs associated with sorting the wire from contaminates will be charged to the hauler.

BACKGROUND:

1. The Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission will accept all wire as per current fee schedule.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES:

1. The waste hauler must inform the scale operator they are hauling wire.
2. The waste hauler will be required to dispose of the material in the designated area.
3. The site operator will inspect the load for any contaminates.
4. The CAO shall be responsible for enforcing this Policy.
5. The CAO shall be responsible for updating, reviewing and presenting recommendations to the Board regarding any changes to this Policy.
