Policy Objective:

To ensure due diligence respecting environmental and fiscal responsibility for accepting, handling and disposing of only those waste generated from within the boundaries established by the Commission Board.

Policy Statement:

The Commission shall accept only those wastes generated from within its established boundaries, unless otherwise approved by resolution of the Commission Board in response to a specific request.

Background:

Traditionally the Commission has only accepted waste from within its own boundaries.

Responsibilities and Authorities:

Subject to Board approval, the CAO shall establish the classifications, conditions, requirements and rates under which all waste shall be accepted for handling, processing and disposal at the waste disposal facilities.

The CAO shall bring forward to the Board for approval, all requests for acceptance of wasted not described in the approved classifications and rate structure.

The CAO shall bring forward to the Board any appeals from any customer regarding the rate charged to the customer at time of disposal at any of our disposal facilities.

The CAO shall be responsible for investigating and retaining all governing regulations currently in force for all types of waste, including wastes not forming part of the approved rate structures.

The CAO shall retain the Commission, subject to approval of the Commission Board, to determine the conditions and terms under which any waste can be rejected from the waste disposal facilities.
